

NJ TRANSIT BUS OPERATIONS EMERGENCY STROBE LIGHT FEATURES

NJ TRANSIT is in the process of installing emergency strobe lights on several types of NJ TRANSIT operated buses used throughout the state.

The strobe lights on NJ TRANSIT operated buses are designed to draw the public's attention to the "EMERGENCY CALL POLICE" message that is displayed on the front destination sign and the "CALL 911" on the back sign. These lights are ***NOT*** used for the same purpose as those found on school buses.

Strobe lights on school buses are designed to provide a warning that a school bus is carrying school age children and provide better visibility to the bus from approaching motorists during dark, early morning, night time conditions.
