About the Instructors:

Ray McCormack is a 28-year veteran of the Fire Department of New York and a lieutenant with Ladder 28 in Harlem. He was previously assigned to Engine 69 for more than 10 years. He is a contributor to *Fire Engineering*, *WNYF*, and other fire service magazines and Web sites. He helped to develop Training Minutes for FireEngineering.com, for which he contributes tips on engine tactics. He is the founder of liveburntraining.com, which provides firefighter training and benefit seminars. He delivered the Keynote Speech at FDIC 2009. Lt. McCormack is the Co-editor and founder of Urbanfirefighter.com.

Emmet "Pat" Nichols is a 25 year veteran with the Boston, Massachusetts FD. He joined the Department in 1986. He is assigned to Tower Ladder 10, where he currently is the company commander. Pat has been an Instructor with the Massachusetts Fire Academy since 1991, where he teaches both recruit, as well as technical rescue course for them.
