Dear Friends:

As you may recall, earlier this year our consultant conducted a feasibility study for Centralized Fire/EMS Dispatch and a 9-1-1 Call Center. The primary objective of such a consolidation is to streamline operations, improve response times, enhance resource coordination, and provide more efficient and cost-effective services to our communities.

We know technology is rapidly changing and with that comes expensive upgrades. Centralized dispatch may allow us to reduce duplication and provide substantial savings without sacrificing safety and efficiency.

Centralized dispatch was considered in Atlantic County several years ago, but opponents exerted pressure and the idea was dismissed. But we are willing to try again.

The study has now been completed. We will provide a presentation of our findings at a meeting of police, fire and EMS representatives, local elected officials and the public on **Monday, December 1 at 6 pm at the Canale Training Center, 5033 English Creek Avenue, Egg Harbor Township.**

Following the presentation, you will have an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments. Our goal is to decide if and how we would like to proceed. Your input is extremely important in this decision-making process.
