

## ATIANTIC COUNTY FIREFIGHTERS' ASSOCIATION

Egg Harbor City

January 16, 2002

The regular meeting of the Atlantic County Firefighters' Association was called to order at 8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, January 16, 2002 with President R. Thomas Hunter Jr. presiding. The meeting was opened with the Flag Salute, followed by Invoacation by Thomas Sweeny, Chaplain of the Association. President Hunter then pointed out the exits.

The Secretary read the rolls to record attendance, and to ensure a quorum being present. Chief Russell Fenton of the Egg Harbor City Fire Department welcomed the membership and the invited guests to Egg Harbor City. Chief Fenton then introduced the Line Officers of the Fire Department as well as introducing Egg Harbor City Mayor James McGeary who extended a warm welcome to all.

President Hunter welcomed and introduced guests Congressman Frank LoBiondo, Assemblyman Frank Blee, Assemblyman Paul D'Amato, Atlantic County Executive Dennis Levinson, Freeholders Kirk W. Conover, James A. Carney, James Curcio, Steven K. The invited guests addressed the membership and expressed their thanks for all of the many services provided by the firefighters to the citizens of Atlantic County.

The Annual Memorial Services were conducted by the Memorial Committee with Chaplain Thomas Sweeny giving the homily, Memorial Candles being lit by Dennis Sharpe and Lou Raciti, with the bell being tolled by Charles Guenther as the Secretary Howard R. Motion seconded and carried to accept and approve the minutes of the previous meeting of December 19, 2001 as forwarded to the Chiefs and Secretaries.

Howard Guenther reported that the Annual Firefighters' dinner is to be held on Friday, March 22, 2002 at The Crab Trap in Somers Pointand a flier is enclosed with the minutes.

The 200 Club Committee reported on the 17th Annual Cape-Atlantic Memorial Service and Breakfast to be held on Sunday, February 24, 2002 to hlnor Police-Fire-Rescue Personnel killed in the line of duty and that tickets may be purchased thru Fire Marshall Whitey Swartz 407-6741 and cost is \$20.00 each. Reserved tables of 10 are available and he will arrange to have seating together as desired. Cutoff date for tickets is Friday, February 15. Memorial Services to be held at St. Nicholas Church in Atlantic City at 10:30 AM followed by Buffet Breakfast at Bally's Atlantic City.

Director of Training Mike Corbo reported that the Spring Course Booklets are available and have been forwarded to all companies. Firefihger 1 is to start on Thursday, February 14th and Firefighter II to start on Monday, March 28th. Other courses are listed in Booklet. Mike reminded all of the Firefighter 1 graduation to be held on Monday, January 28th at 7 PM at the Fire Training Center.

The Executive Committee had 4 recommendations they desired to have action taken on 1. There are still 4 companies owing tuition for courses taken by their firefighters during the 1999 Spring Semester and they recommended that firefighters from these companies still owing 1999 tuition not be accepted for courses until tuition is paid.

- 2. Replacement Instructors are to be added for the Fire Training Academy, some are Level 1 and some Level 2 and they recommended a stipend of \$10.00 per hour for Level 1 instructors and to maintain stipend at \$15.00 for level 2 instructors.
- 3. The Pleasantville Fire Department purchased several new pieces of Apparatus thru Campbell Supply Co. and Campbell Supply Company has donated one of the pumpers they took in on trade to the Firefighters' Association for use by the Fire Training Academy. The Committee recommends that the Firefighters' Association accept the donation of the fire engine pumper from Campbell Supply and turn over ownership to the County for use at the Fire Academy.

  4. The Executive Committee recommends an increase of \$150.00 to the stipped for the Secretary.
